MHPN is a not-for-profit organisation funded by the Federal Government. Our purpose is to support improved client outcomes by supporting interdisciplinary networks across Australia to enhance collaborative mental health care.

MHPN Online Networks:

- Build upon the successful face-to-face network program established in 2008.
- Provide an online platform to connect with other practitioners while accessing free professional development through network meetings.
- Connect a range of disciplines across Australia to build relationships, provide peer support and improve referral pathways.

MHPN Provides:

- A dedicated Project Officer to support the promotion and administration of the online network.
- Funding for network costs.
- Video conference access, including training to host and facilitate network meetings.
- Access to a web portal with customised features including practitioner directory (January 2021).
- Marketing support to promote and grow the network and a coordinator bi-monthly newsletter.
